This position reports to the Sr. Purchasing Manager.

Responsibilities:

- Prepare and maintain accurate customs paperwork and shipping documents for imports and exports.
- File import and export entries and ensure compliance with trade regulations.
- Work with freight forwarders, brokers, and carriers to resolve shipment delays and customs holds.
- Monitor shipments to ensure on-time delivery and proactively address issues.
- Assist with purchase order creation, updates, and follow-up with vendors.
- Create and manage shipping profiles and guides for customers and vendors.
- Generate supply chain and logistics reports using NetSuite and Excel
- Identify opportunities to streamline paperwork and reporting processes.
